

EAST COUNTY CAMPUS CODE OF CONDUCT

The following is a Code of Conduct governing the actions of all participants in, and users of the East County Campus and any program or activity associated within:

1. **PURPOSE OF CODE:** The major purpose of this Code of Conduct is to promote a warming atmosphere and understanding at the East County Campus assuring participants and staff alike that the behavior of all in attendance will be guided by a common set of rules for the mutual benefit of all.
2. **CODE OF CONDUCT:** To accomplish this purpose, individuals are asked to live by one basic guideline. "The rights and privileges of all persons are to be respected and honored at all times."
3. **VIOLATIONS OF CODE:** The following are violations of the East County Campus and are prohibited at the Campus or at Campus-sponsored activities.
 - a) Smoking within 25 feet of all doors or windows of buildings, consuming alcohol or drug use.
 - b) Rude or disrespectful behavior towards East County Campus participants and staff.
 - c) Conduct that disrupts or obstructs any program or activity that is a part of the overall East County Campus operations.
 - d) Any action, event, or group of events that constitutes a violation of Federal, State, or local law.
 - e) Failure to comply with lawful direction or posted signage given by East County Campus staff acting in the performance of their duties.
 - f) The destruction, damage, or theft of the East County Campus property or the property of staff and participants.
 - g) Any lewd, obscene or indecent conduct or expression, including profanity.
 - h) Any action which, in the judgment of staff, constitutes an attempt to inflict, or the actual infliction of, injury to other participants and/or center staff.
 - i) Any conduct or expression that in the judgment of staff, serves to intimidate or coerce others.
 - j) Any infringement on the rights of other participants or staff granted by Federal, State, or local statute or any other violations of such statutes.
 - k) Failure to maintain a level of personal hygiene and clothing attire that is non-offensive in a social environment. Participants without shoes or shirt will be denied access to service.
 - l) All children must be accompanied by an adult. Neglecting to provide proper supervision and control of children at all times.
 - m) Animals are not allowed in food service areas.
 - n) Using the restrooms for bathing, shaving, laundry or washing hair.
4. **ENFORCEMENT:** The above code shall be enforced by the East County staff whose authority shall prevail in all cases. Violations of the code that are deemed to constitute an immediate and apparent threat to the safety of others or their property may result in immediate temporary expulsion from the East County Campus and/or the specific activity.
5. **APPEAL OF ANY DECISION:** Appeal of any decision may be made to the East County Manager or her designee, and a final decision concerning the enforcement of the Code of Conduct.

The above rules are NOT a complete list of regulations, but are intended to be a guideline, staff and/or law enforcement officers are authorized to expel anyone who, after being advised of the regulations, fails to comply. Such personnel also reserve the right to take appropriate action against any other behavior that can reasonably be deemed offensive or inappropriate.
